Purpose

The Ivy MBA Mind to Market Case Challenge brings together science and technology-related organizations and entrepreneurial-minded MBA students for an intense, two-day innovation challenge.

The Ivy College of Business has partnered with the Iowa State University Pappajohn Center for Entrepreneurship to create an exceptional applied learning experience for MBA students interested in innovation and entrepreneurship. The live case will be drawn from a tenant in the Iowa State Research Park, a 220+ acre innovation community and incubator for new and expanding businesses in Ames, Iowa.

- Limited to nine invited teams, including the host university

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Travel

All teams are responsible for making their own travel arrangements (flight, driving, etc.) and covering their own costs to travel to Ames, Iowa. If you are flying, the closest major airport is the <u>Des Moines</u> <u>International Airport (DSM)</u>, which is a 45-minute ride by Uber/Lyft/taxi, <u>Executive Express</u>, or rental car to Ames, Iowa.

Lodging

Iowa State University has reserved a block of rooms at the Gateway Hotel in Ames at a special group rate for March 6-9, 2025. Your \$200 registration fee will be applied toward your hotel accommodations. Teams are responsible for reserving their own rooms at the Gateway Hotel and paying the remaining balance. A registration link will be provided to access the special group rate, along with a reservation deadline.

Registration for the challenge is \$200 and is paid at the time of registration. Registration is non-refundable.

Parking

If you are driving to Ames or renting a car at the airport, there is free parking at the hotel and the Economic Development Core Facility, and free parking on campus during the Thursday evening welcome reception.

Van Service

Iowa State University will provide van service between the hotel and event spaces. This includes the Gateway Hotel, Iowa State University campus, and the Economic Development Core Facility. Departure and arrival times will be communicated. Van service utilization will be asked in a second survey once your university has officially registered for the competition. If your team anticipates needing more travel flexibility, you are advised to rent your own transportation for use throughout the competition.

Teams are responsible for their own transportation to and from the airport.
